

#### **Objectives:-**

- Create cancer awareness and remove the stigma and fear attached.
- Help people recognize the early signs and symptoms of cancer, thus enabling them to seek treatment at an early stage.
- Educate people about the key risk factors, since more than 30% of cancer cases could be prevented by modifying lifestyle or avoiding the risk factors.
- Inform people about the importance of regular screening and check-ups.
- Inform women about mammograms, clinical breast exam and breast self-exam.
- Inform women about Pap smear tests to check for signs of cervical cancer.

Jagadambha College of Engineering and technology Yavatmal, The Women Empowerment Cell of our Engineering College organised a cancer awareness programme recently. For the organization of this program the event coordinator Dr. M. B. Wasu had taken permission from the hon'ble Principal. With the authorities permission Dr.Wasu had taken the consent of Dr. Kavita Borkar and invited her to guide the ladies staff. The first I/C had formed the program committee and called the meeting of the committee members to explain the respective responsibilities of the staff for smooth conduction of program.

On the 19th October 2023, the program was inaugurated at the hands of Dr. Sneha Rathod

First year I/C- Prof. M. A. Khan and Dr. M. B. Wasu had introduced the guest. The principal Dr. V. L. Bhambere felicitated the guest by offering a shawl, shrifal, bouquet and memento. In the inaugural speech Dr. M. B. Wasu Faculty of the First Year Department had



emphasized the importance of this Program and advised ladies to identify their potential, think positively and to be confident about their capabilities.

Dr. Kavita Borkar explained and discussed following points with staff & Students:

### What is breast cancer

Breast cancer is a group of diseases in which cells in breast tissue change and divide uncontrolled, typically resulting in a lump or mass. Most breast cancers begin in the lobules (milk glands).

### What are the signs and symptoms of breast cancer

Breast cancer typically has no symptoms when the tumor is small and most easily treated, which is why screening is important for early detection. The most common physical sign is a painless lump.

### How is breast cancer diagnosed

Breast cancer is typically detected either during screening, before symptoms have developed, or after a woman notices a lump. Most masses seen on a mammogram and most breast lumps turn out to be benign (not cancerous).

#### Diet

Numerous studies have examined the relationship between food consumption (including fat, fiber, soy, dairy, meat, and fruits and vegetables) and breast cancer with mixed results. A recent meta-analysis concluded there was no association between breast cancer and dietary fat consumption.

### **Breast self-awareness**

All women should become familiar with both the appearance and feel of their breasts and report any changes promptly to their physician. If a lump or other symptoms develop, women should contact a doctor immediately, even after a recent normal mammogram.

In the last session Dr. Kavita Borkar had explained the tricks of self-defense through video clips. At the end of the program Dr. Wasu had proposed the vote of thanks expressing, gratefulness towards a chief guest that she could spend her valuable time among the ladies of a
